A bronze medal and \$5,000 honorarium are awarded for an outstanding record in computer science and engineering education. The individual must meet two or more of the following criteria in the computer science and engineering field:

Achieving recognition as a teacher of renown.

Writing an influential text.

Leading, inspiring, or providing significant education content during the creation of a curriculum in the field.

Inspiring others to a career in computer science and engineering education.

Three endorsements are required for an award nomination.

Self-nominations are not accepted.

## Mary Kenneth Keller Computer Science and Engineering Undergraduate Teaching Award

A certificate and \$2,000 honorarium are awarded to recognize outstanding contributions to undergraduate education through both teaching and service and for helping to maintain interest, increasing the visibility of the society, and making a statement about the importance of undergraduate education.

The award nomination requires a minimum of two endorsements.

Self-nominations are not accepted.
