

The proposed Constitutional amendments are listed below. Revisions are indicated by tracked changes. Only the revised sections are included. Other sections without revisions were omitted.

These amendments are intended to align our Constitution with IEEE Bylaw I-105, which states that Graduate Student Members are entitled to all rights and privileges of an IEEE member. The amendments also clarify that the Computer Society secretary is “selected” by the Board of Governors rather than “elected” by Computer Society members.

If approved by members, the Constitutional amendments will be effective in sixty days.

ARTICLE IV - OFFICERS

Section 1:

The elected officers of the Society shall be the president, the president-elect, the vice president, and the past president . Other officers may be provided for in the bylaws. The president-elect and vice president of the Society shall be elected annually. The election procedures shall be as specified in the bylaws. The secretary shall be selected annually by the Board of Governors as specified in the bylaws. These officers must hold graduate student member grade or higher in the IEEE and must have been Society members for the preceding three years. When taking office as president, president-elect, or vice president, such officers of the Society vacate their elected Board positions if they currently hold one. The president shall with advice and consent of the Board appoint all non-elected officers. These appointed officers must hold the graduate member grade or higher in the Society.
